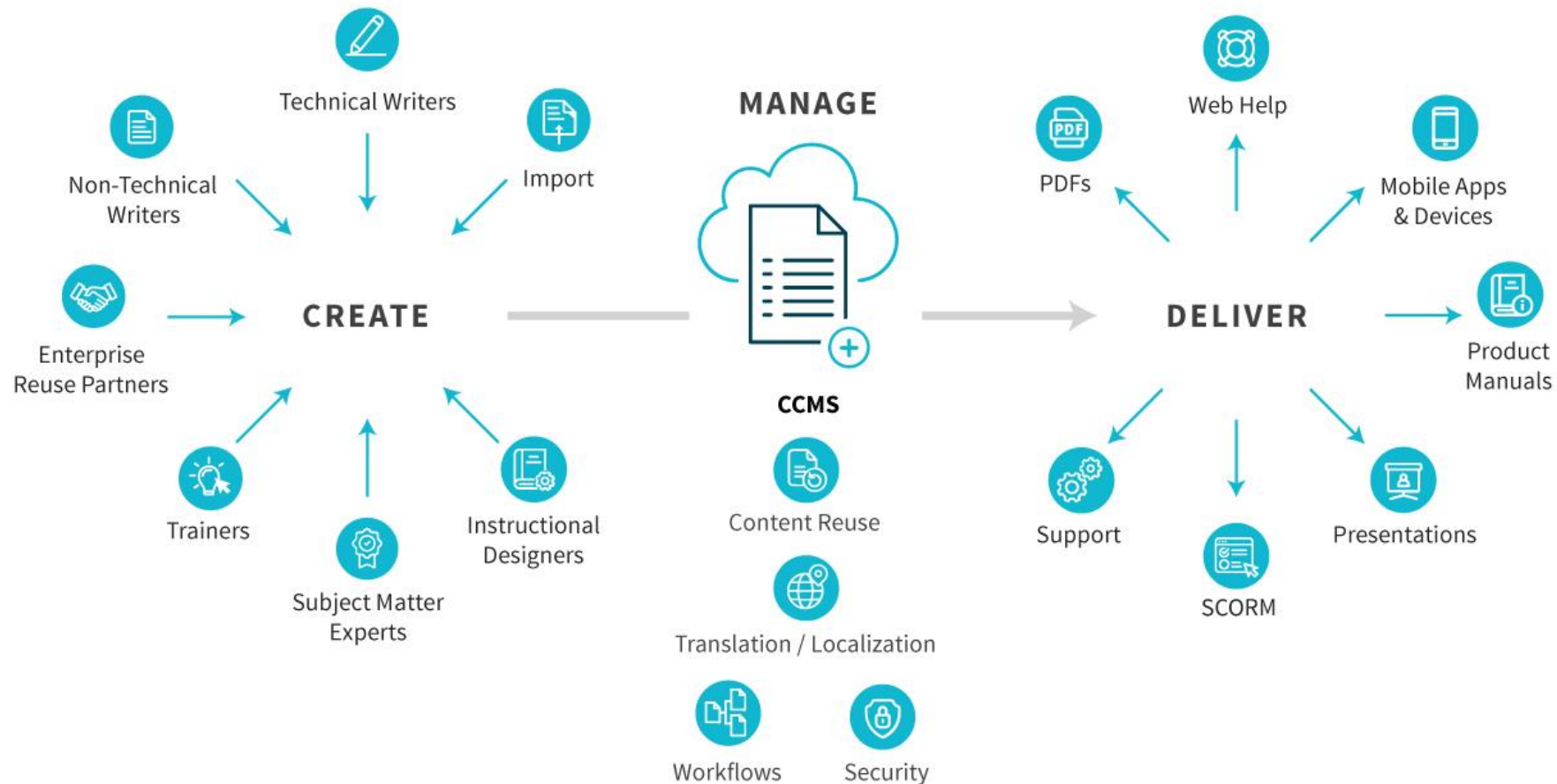

Create any number of themes using standards based CSS3 paged media style sheets.



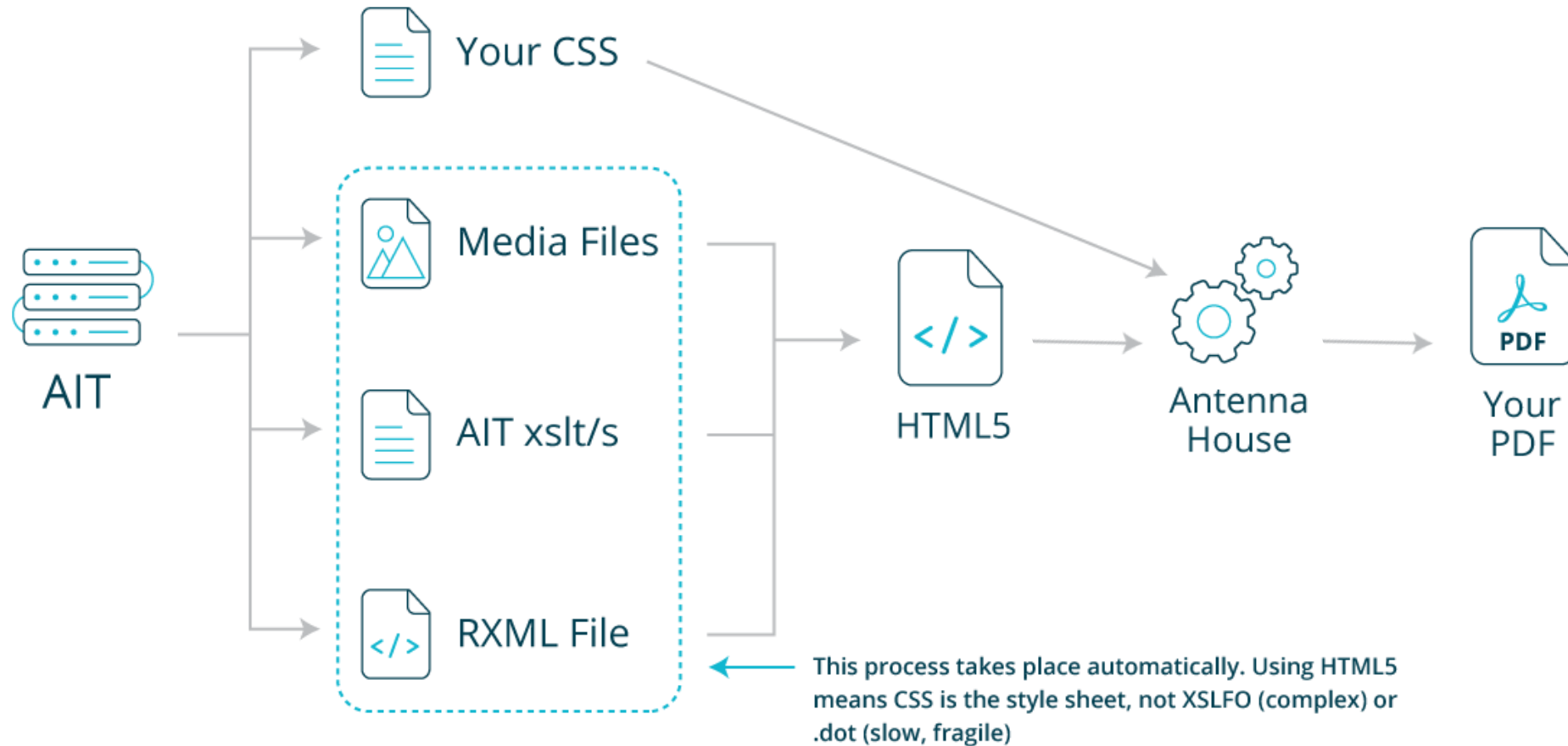

Download and install Antenna House Formatter

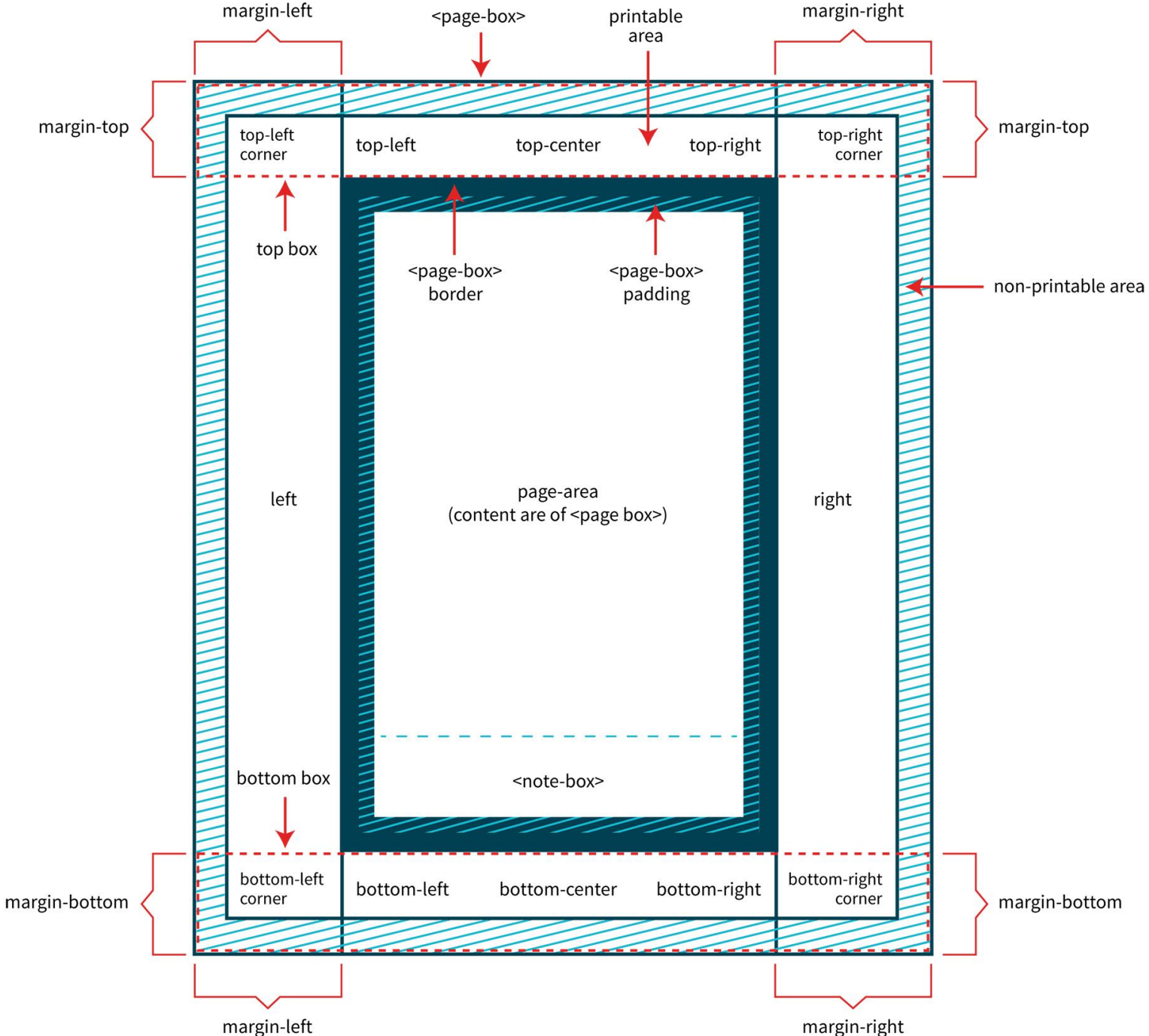
